### Memory Verses

**Eph 5:15** - Be very careful, then, how you live - not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil.

**Acts 2:46-37** - Everyday they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.
